Orientation Training a 60-minute orientation on your BenQ Board. This is normally offered online and will

give you all the information you need to begin using our BenQ Board.

Management System

Training

a 60-minute online course designed for the Tech Team. This course covers the backend management systems – DMS/IAM/AMS/Broadcast and will take you through the steps to establish your organization's account, load your faculty / staff into the system, edit their account information as well as how to use the Broadcast system to send messages / content to your BenQ Boards.

Fee-Based Professional Development

Half-Day Professional Development

a 3-hour, on-site, hands-on course designed to give your BenQ users a deeper understanding of the uses of their interactive display. This is often bundled into a full day session, with one group in a morning session and another group in an afternoon session.

Full Day Professional Development

Either two Half-Day sessions back-to-back (see above), or a single session with one group. If a single session with one group, it will be customized to the needs of the group.

Train the Trainer

a 2-day, 12-hour course, designed for Tech Teams, Educational Coaches, etc., within the organization who then are responsible for training the faculty / staff. This will be a hands-on, deep dive into the BenQ Board and provide troubleshooting steps as well as other content that will be helpful in training users of BenQ Boards.

Certified BenQ Educator™ a 2-day, 12-hour, hands-on course designed for teachers who want to take their BenQ skills a step further.

Certified BenQ Trainer™ a 3-day, 18-hour, hands-on course designed for educators to become *Certified BenQ*
